Rubio Responds to Crist Announcement

(Miami, FL) – Marco Rubio issued the following statement in response to Governor Crist's entry into the race for U.S. Senate: "I welcome Charlie Crist to the 2010 Republican primary for the United States Senate. Our primary will offer Republicans a front row seat to a debate about the future of the Republican Party here in Florida and across the nation. My campaign will offer GOP voters a clear alternative to the direction some want to take our party. Let the debate begin."
