## **Will Bill Nelson Cave To The DNC?**

***National Democrats Attack Nelson, Other 'Moderate' Democrats On Health Care***

**WASHINGTON** – In an unprecedented move today, the Democrat National Committee (DNC) announced that it will launch a wave of television ads aimed at pressuring “moderate” Democrats in Congress such as U.S. Senator Bill Nelson (D-FL) to ensure they toe the party line on the President’s government-run health care plan. According to *Bloomberg News* [this morning](#), the White House “may rely only on Democrats” to ram this massive bill through Congress in just the next two and a half weeks.

As ABC News [reported](#) this morning, “Pressuring Democrats to follow the president on health care reform marks a strategic shift by the DNC – and represents the biggest gamble yet by the president’s old campaign apparatus to turn the campaign’s 13-million-person-plus army into legislative action... While Democrats now control 60 Senate seats – enough to break a Republican filibuster – not all Democrats are backing Obama’s plan.”

**“As the DNC engages its 13-million-person email list to bulldoze Bill Nelson on health care, Floridians are watching to see if he will give in to these pressures, or if he will stand up against the massive spending and small business tax hikes that will likely be included in the Democrats’ costly government-run health care proposal,”** said National Republican Senatorial Committee (NRSC) spokeswoman Amber Wilkerson. **“Will Senator Nelson represent the best interests of families and small businesses in Florida, or will he bend to coercion from Washington and serve as a rubber stamp for national Democrats who are trying to ram through another massive bill without adequate review?”**
