**BAKER COUNTY SHERIFF ADDS NAME TO GROWING
LIST OF LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICIALS ENDORSING
SENATOR DAVE ARONBERG FOR
ATTORNEY GENERAL**

Baker County Sheriff Joey Dobson announced his support for Senator Dave Aronberg for Attorney General today – the sixth Democratic Sheriff to do so.

“Dave Aronberg is ready to serve as Florida’s next Attorney General,” Sheriff Dobson said. “His experience serving as an assistant attorney general, and his legislative record of sponsoring and securing the passage of stronger public safety laws make him the top pick to be Florida’s next Attorney General,” Sheriff Dobson said.

Sheriff Dobson joins the growing list of active law enforcement officials who have endorsed Aronberg for Attorney General, including: Alachua County Sheriff Sadie Darnell, Hendry County Sheriff Steve Whidden, Palm Beach County Sheriff Ric Bradshaw, Glades County Sheriff Stuart Whiddon, and St. Lucie County Sheriff Ken Mascara.
